1. HTML Structure

This template is based on Twitter Bootstrap 3+. Template has many sections like Navigation Section, Search Section, Footer Section, Listing Section, Content Section etc. Template can be easily modified as per requirements. General structure of template is

```
/* PRELOADER SECTION */
```

If you would like to edit the color, font, or style of any elements throughout the template you can do that easily. For example if you wish to change font or color of the FILTER TITLE, you would do the following

```
.filter-area h5 {  
    Color: #f9676b;  
    Font-family: 'Open Sans', 'sans serif';  
}
```

If you find that your new style is not overriding, it is most likely because of a specificity problem. Scroll down in your CSS file and make sure that there isn't a similar style that has more weight.

2. CSS Files and Structure

Mainly template uses two CSS file first is style.css and another is color scheme file. Color file contains styles that are used to give color to the template. Secondly there is style.css file which is the backbone of the template and it contains all the necessary styles that gives the feel and look to the template. Styles in the style.css file has been divided into multiple sections i.e preloader section, nav section, footer section etc. Most importantly style.css has page wise style section as well. There are 47 section in style.css file some of them are

If you would like to edit a specific section of the site, simply find the appropriate label in the CSS file, and then scroll down until you find the appropriate style that needs to be edited.

If you would like to edit the color, font, or style of any elements throughout the template you can do that easily. For example if you wish to change font or color of the FILTER TITLE, you would do the following

3. JavaScript

This template imports three Javascript files.

1. jQuery
2. My custom scripts (js.js)
3. Some plugin

1. jQuery is a Javascript library that greatly reduces the amount of code that you must write.
2. Since most of the animation in the template are carried out using CSS3 so there is very little involved in the template. Since there are few areas which needs javascript. Javascript file contains various initializations like Owl Carousel, jquery UI elements like date picker spinner, range slider etc. Javascript files contains proper commenting to help you better understand the structure and modification. You can change Datepicker range, slider range, carousel speed and items etc. using the js.js file. For example if you wish to change the range if the datepicker you would do following

```
$( "#departure_date" ).datepicker({ minDate: -0, maxDate: "+3M" });
```

change minDate and maxDate parameter to suit your needs.

Similarly you can play with Owl Carousel. If you wish to change the setting of recent post carousel you can do that by changing following parameter as per your requirements

```
if (jQuery("#post-list").length){  
  
    jQuery("#post-list").owlCarousel({  
  
        loop:true,
```

```
margin:30,

responsiveClass:true,

autoplay:false,

autoplayTimeout:5000,

navigation:false,

stopOnHover:true,

responsive:{

    0:{

        items:1,

        loop:true

    },

    600:{

        items:2,

        loop:true

    },

    1000:{

        items:4,

        loop:true

    }

}

});

}
```
